NURTURE SESSIONS

Canopy Forest School can bring a series of sessions for small groups of children (maximum of twelve) who need extra support with their confidence, resilience and self-esteem. Engaging with the natural environment helps to build the 'soft skills' that support social and emotional development

ALSO INCLUDED:

INDIVIDUAL CHILD REPORTS

We produce a report at the end of every term for each child which depicts the holistic learning that has taken place, skills and knowledge and personal development of each child.

ECOLOGICAL IMPACT REPORT

Before we start our Forest School sessions with you we will conduct a survey of your grounds and create an ecological report which is a formal system that identifies and creates an inventory of all the flora and fauna that exist in the area, the topography, substratum, site history/antiquity, site ownership, management and protection. This process evaluates the factors which will support and enhance our interactions with this space.

SUSTAINABLE SCHOOL GROUNDS PLAN


This plan outlines the proposed actions for looking after the woodland area that Canopy Forest School will occupy.
