OUR AFTER SCHOOL FOREST SCHOOL SESSIONS

Forest School is a unique experiential learning process which aims to build up children's skills, abilities and confidence week by week through practical hands-on activities in the outdoors. It gives them the chance to explore, learn and discover at their own pace in a safe and supportive space. Forest School uses natural resources to stimulate imagination, creativity and investigation.

ECOLOGICAL IMPACT REPORT

Before we set up and start running Forest School sessions at your school we will conduct a survey of your grounds and create an ecological report which is a formal system that identifies and creates an inventory of all the flora and fauna that exist in the area, the topography, substratum, site history/antiquity, site ownership, management and protection. This process evaluates the factors which will support and enhance our interactions with this space.

SUSTAINABLE SCHOOL GROUNDS PLAN

We will also produce a sustainable School grounds plan which will outline the proposed actions for looking after area that any outdoor learning will occupy. It will also outline the impact that this learning will have on the environment.

WHAT WE DO?

The learning "Experience" that we offer is based within a natural environment and is founded upon an internal process of holistic development. Each session allows its participants to have the time and space to make their own choices, take controlled risks and express themselves creatively in a play-based child-led way.

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OUR AFTER SCHOOL SESSIONS

Our after school sessions will take place within the grounds of your child's school.

Come and make new friends, meet up with old ones and breath in the wonders of the natural world. You will experience first hand the joy of learning through nature and the beauty of each changing season. Our experienced staff will support, scaffold and facilitate a wide range of Forest School activities that will build self-esteem, confidence, creativity, language, fine and gross motor skills and are above everything else great fun! Our programme comprises of six or more sessions with groups of 12 toddlers. We will be offering activities such as: den building, tree climbing, making nature crafts, going on scavenger hunts, sensory play, mud kitchen and water fun . Or you and your child might just want to take some relaxing time out in a hammock reading a good book.

Every week we will also provide you with a complimentary drink and a healthy snack. We also have a fully equipment nappy changing tent and children's toilet.

ALSO INCLUDED:

Our sessions run all year during the school term in all weather (unless it is unsafe) so it is vital that you and your child are dressed in the appropriate kit (a kit list will be sent out to you on enrolment).

At the end of every half term we will produce an individual report for each child which depicts and celebrates the holistic learning, the skills, knowledge and personal development that has taken place.
